**Care4All California, established in 2018, is a broad-based grassroots campaign to achieve universal health care in California and raise the bar for the nation.**

**Care4All California includes consumer, community, labor, progressive, and health care organizations working together to attain:**



**Universal coverage** - by protecting current coverage gains and expanding Californians' access to health care regardless of their immigration status, age, disability, income, or other factors.



**Affordable coverage** - with increased financial assistance in Covered California to reduce premiums and out of pocket costs, so no Californian pays more than a certain percent of their income for their health care coverage.



**Improved health outcomes and a reduction in disparities** - by requiring insurers to meet new goals centered on consumers' needs, rather than profits.



**Lower costs for consumers** - by holding hospitals, health plans, and drug companies accountable for fair prices.
